VBS Planning Meeting



Blood Pressures: Please bring a list of your medications. if you take medication for your blood pressure, please take the medication before arriving at the church.

An information fact sheet will be provided that discusses what you need to know about blood pressure values.

Blood Glucose: If you would like your blood glucose (sugar) value performed, please fast (nothing to eat or drink after 12 midnight). Breakfast items will be available after the test is completed.

Pulse Oximeter: This test monitors the oxygen in arterial blood. Normal values should read between 90 to 93 when sitting. An information handout to define Pulse Oximeter will be available.

Educational handouts will be available that discuss having a healthy life style. Plan to stop by and take advantage of one or all of these services.

Asparagus and Mozzarella Stuffed Chicken Breast

2 large skinless, boneless chicken breast halves salt and black pepper to taste 8 asparagus spears, trimmed - divided 1/2 cup shredded mozzarella cheese, divided 1/4 cup Italian seasoned bread crumbs


Preheat an oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C). Grease an 8x8-inch baking dish.

Place each chicken breast between two sheets of heavy plastic (resealable freezer bags work well) on a solid, level surface. Firmly pound the chicken with the smooth side of a meat mallet to an even thickness of about 1/4 inch. Sprinkle each side with salt and pepper.

Place 4 spears of asparagus down the center of a chicken breast, and spread about 1/4 cup of mozzarella cheese over the asparagus. Repeat with the other chicken breast, and roll the chicken around the asparagus and cheese to make a tidy, compact roll. Place the rolls seam sides down in the prepared baking dish, and sprinkle each with about 2 tablespoons of bread crumbs.

Bake in the preheated oven until the juices run clear when pricked with a fork, about 25 minutes. An instant-read thermometer inserted into the center should read at least 165 degrees F (74 degrees C).
