Examining the Evidence: The Case for Christ

This month we continue our series on The Case for Christ: Examining the Evidence. Let this inspire us to a deeper appreciation of the life, death and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus. This leads us to celebrate the most sacred time in the life of the church-Holy Week. Beginning with Palm Sunday we remember Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem as a wel-

comed messiah, even though Jesus knew he would shortly give his life in agony on the cross. We will have a special concert worship with our very special guests, The Black Voices of Inspiration with a single service Palm Sunday Concert at 10:45 am.

On Maundy Thursday, we recall Jesus' Last Supper with a special Seder Meal in the Fellowship Hall at 6:00 PM, which will close with a special Last Supper Communion Service.



Buffalo Sausage Cheese Dip

1 package Turkey Sausage Crumbles 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, cubed, softened

½ cup sour cream

1/4 cup Louisiana brand hot sauce

2 tablespoons chopped celery

½ cup (2 ounces) blue cheese crumbles

Baked pita chips or celery sticks for dipping

Heat and stir sausage crumbles in a large skillet over medium heat for 4-5 minutes or until hot. Add cream cheese, sour cream and hot sauce.

Cook and stir until cream cheese is melted and sauce is smooth. Stir in blue cheese and celery; heat 2 minutes or until cheese is melted. Spoon into serving dish or chafing

Serve with chips and celery sticks.


